

## Online Manuscripts Submission

*Call For Manuscripts:* The Conference is currently accepting original high-quality research manuscripts for publication. The Conference welcomes the submission of manuscripts that meet the scientific criteria of significance and academic excellence. All research articles submitted for the Conference will be peer-reviewed within three months of submission. Following the peer-reviewed acceptance, the accepted & formatted articles will normally be published in the next available issue.

*Article Types for Submission:* All submitted formatted full-text articles should report original, previously unpublished research results, experimental or theoretical. Articles submitted to the Conference should meet these criteria and must not be under consideration for publication elsewhere. These articles should describe new and carefully confirmed findings, and experimental procedures should be given in sufficient detail for others to verify the work. The length of a full text article should be 4 or 6 pages long, required to describe and interpret the work clearly.

*Instructions for Authors:* The Conference will only accept manuscripts submitted through [Online Conference Manuscripts Submission link](#). Electronic submission of manuscripts is strongly encouraged, provided that the text, tables, and figures are included in a single PDF output of [Microsoft Word file](#) and [Copyright Transfer Form](#) where detailed instructions can be found on preparing manuscripts for submission.

*Abstract:* The manuscript should contain an abstract. The abstract should be self-contained and citation-free and should not exceed 150 words.

*Keywords:* Add about four key words or phrases in alphabetical order, separated by commas.

*Introduction:* This section should be succinct, with no subheadings.

*Acknowledgments:* All acknowledgments (if any) should be included at the very end of the manuscript before the references and may include supporting grants, presentations, and so forth.

*References:* Authors are responsible for ensuring that the information in each reference is complete and accurate. All references must be numbered consecutively and citations of references in text should be identified using numbers in square brackets (e.g., “as discussed by Smith [9]”; “as discussed elsewhere [9, 10]”). All references should be cited within the text; otherwise, these references will be automatically removed.

*Preparation of Figures:* Each figure should be embedded in the electronic manuscript file. All figures should be cited in the manuscript in a consecutive order. Each figure is subject to resizing to fit into the column's width of or the full text width for consistency and clarity. The labels of the figures are also subject to resizing to be of minimum 9pt according to conferences in-house specifications.

*Preparation of Tables:* Tables should be cited consecutively in the text. Every table must have a descriptive title and if numerical measurements are given, the units should be included in the column heading. Vertical rules should not be used.

*Units of Measurement:* Units of measurement should be presented simply and concisely using System International (SI) units. A list of non-standard Abbreviations should be added in the articles. In general, non-standard abbreviations should be used only when the full term is very long and used often. Each abbreviation should be spelled out and introduced in parentheses the first time it is used in the text. Prospective authors should submit their full text manuscripts using the online manuscript submission form.

*Peer-Review Process:* All submitted manuscripts are peer-reviewed by an editor and members of the Editorial Board or qualified outside reviewers. Decisions will be made as rapidly as possible, and the Conference strives to return reviewers' comments to authors within three months. The editorial board will re-review manuscripts that are accepted pending revision. It is the goal of the Conference to publish manuscripts within one month after submission.

*Proofs and Reprints:* Electronic proofs will be sent (e-mail attachment) to the corresponding author as a PDF file. Page proofs are considered to be the final version of the manuscript. With the exception of typographical or minor clerical errors, no changes will be made in the manuscript at the proof stage. Because the Conference will be published freely online and on CD, authors will have free electronic access to the full text PDF of the article.

*Copyright Transfer:* Submission of a manuscript implies: that the work described has not been published before (except in the form of an abstract or as part of a published lecture, or thesis) that it is not under consideration for publication elsewhere; that if and when the manuscript is accepted for publication, the authors agree to automatic transfer of the copyright to the publisher. One of the authors of the manuscript should sign the [Copyright Statement form](#) of their manuscripts, and all open access articles are distributed under the terms of the Creative Commons Attribution license, which permits unrestricted use, distribution and reproduction in any medium, provided that the original work is properly cited.
